

Minute to the Parties

[1] On 21 March 2011 the following documents were received for filing by the Environment Court:

- (a) An amended application for an enforcement order;
- (b) Notice of an amended application for an enforcement order;
- (c) An unsworn affidavit; and
- (d) A list of names and addresses of persons to be served with the application

- all of the documents are dated 24 February 2011.

[2] By memorandum dated 25 March 2011 the Christchurch City Council advised that, for a variety of reasons, it is not in a position to comply with the court's directions given at the pre-hearing conference held on 9 March 2011. It seeks the timetable directions be vacated.

[3] I am satisfied that good grounds exist for vacating the timetable directions but decline to make any further directions at this stage.

[4] The affidavit filed by Mr Snoep is not in the correct format and has not been sworn. Before any further directions are made a sworn affidavit is to be filed and served on the parties. Mr Snoep should consider taking legal advice if he is uncertain as to the court's requirements in this regard.

[5] At the time of filing Mr Snoep is to confirm service (including the date and means that this was achieved). He is also to confirm whether he has served Mr Rankin.

[6] Further directions will be given when the correct documentation is provided to the court.
